

What is the TITLE 1 READING PROGRAM?



A federally funded program that supports the reading needs of students in grades 1-3.

How:

- work in small groups
- read at appropriate levels
- use games and activities to learn skills
- coordinate skills with classroom standards and goals
- involve parents in reading at home

Students are placed through:

- test scores and timed readings
- teacher recommendation

Evaluation Measures:

- progress monitoring
- individual goals
- parent conferences
