The Bridge

What The Bridge is:

The Bridge is a faith based transitional housing program that provides-rent free housing, resources, case management, education and counseling for women and their children. Women that come to The Bridge may live there for up to two years. As residents, they are required to participate in The Bridge program and follow house policy. Each family has their own room and access to a common living room & kitchen area.

All residents who enter into The Bridge's program must be aware that the Bridge is faith-based and implements faith into everyday living. Residents are not required to attend church, but are required to attend Bible Study arranged by The Bridge.

Who The Bridge Helps:

- Mothers who are working with the Department of Human Services and seeking reunification with their children.
- Women who are pregnant and lacking resources for themselves and their child.
- Women who have been a victim of circumstances or domestic violence.
- Women who have just completed a recovery program and are in need of transitional housing.
- Women who have been incarcerated and need a place to live after they are released.
- Women who have been evicted or who can't pay their rent.
- Any situation where homelessness is present or is likely to happen soon.

Why we are donating:

At Unity, one of our goals is to serve the community. As a football team, this is a small way that we can serve some people in need right in our own community. The Bridge is a great faith based organization that seeks to help those in need and provide loving support in a way that shows Christ's love.
