Academics

- From transitional kindergarten through eighth grade, students learn about God's order, design, grace, and sovereignty in every area they study - art, Bible, language arts, science, math, social studies, reading, music, physical education, and technology.
- Hands-on technology enhances our comprehensive curriculum. Our dedicated teachers deliver the full educational experience to their students, while also understanding the uniqueness of each child and adapting as needed.
- Enhanced programs with dedicated staff are available for all students through our inclusive education program.
- Every teacher is state certified, and we are accredited with Christian Schools International and the lowa Department of Education.



Opportunities

- Music can often be heard in our halls: from songs of praise in the classrooms, to music class (where students learn the fundamentals) to participation in musicals, orchestra, and band.
- Students participate in drama through classroom skits, chapel drama troupe, and an annual junior high production.
- Physical activity is encouraged through P.E. and recess. In junior high, team sports in soccer, volleyball, basketball and track are available.

Faith Nurturing

- Every school day in every classroom begins with devotions and every day ends with prayer.
- Each month, the entire student body gathers for chapel, centered around a theme. God's Word is brought to hearts and minds through singing, skits or a message by a local pastor.
- We follow a Bible memory plan that tucks God's Word in students' hearts for life. A Faith Formation Journal also encourages students to record their faith as they progress through the grades.

Resources

- A school counselor and registered nurse are available.
- Paraprofessionals in the classrooms provide support to students who need it.
- The library, resource room, and Discovery program are integral to the school day for many students.
- Hands-on learning technology (including tablets, SMART Boards) in every classroom, and mobile computer labs) are supported by a full-time technology coordinator.
- A daily school lunch program is offered, as well as bus transportation.
