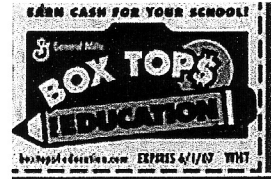


Labels For Education Newsletter

Sioux Center Christian School will again be collecting **Campbells labels**, **Box Tops**, **Tyson tear strips** and **Pizza Ranch logos**. A new item to save this year is the **Land O Lakes milk jug lids**. SCCS earns money and merchandise for items otherwise discarded in the trash. Please encourage grandparents, neighbors and friends to save labels for SCCS. A collection container for the labels is located in the main entrance of the school.



- UPC's on **Campbells Soup** products are redeemable for merchandise. UPC's from **Franco-American, Pepperidge Farm, Swanson, and Market Day** products are included in the Campbells project.
- The Campbells company will no longer accept the front label from eligible products. Turn in the entire label of eligible products and I will clip the UPC's. Please inform grandparents and neighbors who save labels of this change in redemption.
- Save the lid from **V8** and **Prego** products.
- Last year 10,000 labels were turned in for SCCS.
- Two overhead projectors were purchased with Campbells points.

- small Box Tops coupons found on many products can be redeemed for cash for SCCS.
- each Box Top is worth \$.10 for SCCS
- Box Tops can be found on **General Mills** products, **Pillsbury, Yoplait, Betty Crocker, Totino's, Nature Valley, Old El Paso, Ziploc, Kleenex, Scott and Viva** towels, **Cottenelle** paper products.
- Last year our school received a check for \$2169 from Box Tops.



- Continue to save the tear-off wagon logos on **Pizza Ranch** boxes.
- Each logo is worth \$.25 for SCCS
- Last year our school received approximately \$1400 from Pizza Ranch logos.



- Save the **Tyson** strip on the package that says **Project A+ Support Your School**.
- Each strip is worth \$.25 for SCCS.

- save **Land O Lakes Milk** and **Orange Juice caps** with the **Save 5c For Schools** sticker affixed
- lids must be turned in clean and sanitary
- Each lid is worth \$.05 for SCCS
