

Immunization Policy

Updated June 2016

Sioux Center Christian School will meet the standards set by the Iowa Department of Public Health.

All students will have an immunization record or valid exemption on file to attend school. Without these records, students will be excluded from school and all school activities until the correct documentation is turned in.

Immunization records will be audited within the first quarter. Parents will receive notification if their students do not have the required immunizations. A provisional form will be granted, giving parents 60 calendar days to fully immunize their students or begin a series of immunizations as needed. If, after the 60 calendar days, documentation has not been provided to the school, the students will be excluded from school and all school activities.

Students with medical or religious exemptions on file may be excluded from school and school activities during an epidemic or emergent outbreak of communicable disease, as determined by administration or the state board of health.
