

Does your student need to see the eye doctor? Sight for Students is a program that offers gift certificates to help pay for a vision exam and glasses for students who qualify. Qualifying students must:

- Be 19 years old or younger
- Have a U.S. Social Security number
- Have a family income at or under 200% of Federal Poverty Level guidelines

- Not have used a VSP program in the last 12 months, and
- Have no other vision insurance coverage through Medicaid, Hawk-I, or private vision insurance
