Regular Archery Season: December – March

An Archery unit will be taught during PE by Mr. Groskreutz this winter for 4th–8th grades. We expect it will be taught in the fall next school year.

Practice will be offered once per week.

We hope to participate in and host archery tournaments with other local schools. There is also a state tournament at the end of March for those who qualify.

Tournaments are not required. Students may choose to attend only practices. Missing a practice is OK.

This is a starter year, but with strong interest, SCCS hopes to fully launch competitive archery in the 2026–2027 school year.
