### **NICSTO Tax Credit Opportunity for Donors**

(Northwest Iowa Christian School Tuition Organization)

The state of Iowa has recognized the need to support taxpayers who wish to support Christian education. Iowa taxpayers can receive an **Iowa tax credit equal to 65%** of their donation to a School Tuition Organization such as NICSTO. In addition, part of your gift might also qualify for a federal tax deduction, if you itemize. The NICSTO program includes sixteen schools in NW Iowa and is a great tax benefit to those who will be paying Iowa taxes on their income, while **blessing many families with tuition assistance.** 

#### How does it work?

- 1. You must owe lowa state income tax.
- 2. You **make out a check to NICSTO** (Northwest Iowa Christian School Tuition Organization) and designate "Sioux Center Christian School" on the "Contribution Memo" form.
- 3. Complete the **Contribution Memo form** and send it with the check to Sioux Center Christian School.
- 4. In early January, you will receive an lowa tax credit certificate to attach to your lowa tax form. The tax credit is taken directly off the amount you owe in lowa State taxes.

A \$10,000 donation to NICSTO receives a 65% **lowa tax credit** of \$6,500 on your 2020 IA income tax. You might also be able to deduct \$3,500 (35% of donation) on your Federal Income Tax return, if you itemize.

If you are 70½ or older, your **IRA charitable rollover distribution** may be gifted to NICSTO, with the double advantage of not counting as income while you still receive the 65% lowa tax credit.

Gifts in kind of grain, stock, and bonds may also be received.

# Please visit with your tax professional for specific tax implications and advice on how to best enjoy the donation opportunities of NICSTO.

Your donation to NICSTO directly benefits Sioux Center Christian families. In the 2019-20 school year, 126 families received a total of \$219,400 to help cover tuition costs.

#### The Sioux Center Christian School contribution goal for 2020-21 is \$364,872.
