We are absolutely thrilled to be planning for a return to face-to-face learning with our treasured students starting Tuesday, August 25. We engaged in extensive planning during the months of June and July and are confident that our plan implements common-sense, sustainable, and impactful mitigations that help fulfill our goal of keeping as many students as possible on campus as consistently as possible.

If you would like to see the details of our Community Care Plan, please go to www.siouxcenterchristian.com > Parent Center > Community Care Plan. Here's a summary:

- Our goal is to do what's best for God's kids: provide a continuity of Christcentered learning in regular community with one another and under the direction of skilled teachers who love the Lord and love God's kids. We have plans to synchronously teach students who cannot join in-person learning due to their health.
- We will focus on and support all areas of health: physical, mental, social, emotional, and spiritual.
- We will not require masks for students or employees, but we will welcome and support any student or employee who wishes to wear one.
- We are following the guidance of the CDC and Iowa Department of Public Health on exposure to COVID-19: If you have been within 6 feet of someone positively diagnosed with COVID-19 for at least 15 continuous minutes without a mask, starting from 48 hours before the person had symptoms until their time of isolation, then you are considered EXPOSED to COVID-19, but you are not considered contagious (people close to you are not exposed). We have no requirement to get tested.
- Classrooms will have desks arranged in "pods" so that when students are learning together in intervals longer than 15 minutes, their exposure will be limited to a smaller number of students. This keeps learning more like normal while limiting exposure.

We have a long list of plans that we are gladly implementing so that the return to school is safe, yet as normal as possible. Our most important plans still center on training God's children in His Way and helping them discover God's Story and His fingerprints in all things.
