- Is organized, flexible, patient, responsible, and able to recognize and celebrate students' gifts
- Feels comfortable reporting information to teachers and parents
- Is uniquely equipped by God to work in a counseling role with students one-on-one, in small groups, and in the classroom; and is able to and willing to design and organize parental information events
- Has an understanding of the Response to Intervention and Teaching for Transformation frameworks, or the willingness to learn
- Has an understanding of how to write and update student support plans, serve as a case manager, partner with teachers, coach and support general education teachers

The candidate should have a valid lowa teaching license that includes the Professional School Counselor K-8 endorsement or be willing to gain that certification after employment. This position has the potential for full- or part-time.
